ELIGIBILITY

Scholarship applications will be accepted from students who are currently enrolled in a full-time post-secondary institution or students in Grade 12 who are planning to attend a full-time post-secondary education institution that are of Aboriginal descent (First Nations, Métis or Inuit). Students pursuing an education in the technology and trades are considered priority applicants.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Applicants must complete an HJOC application form.
2. Applicants must provide (2) character reference letters.
3. Applicants must be enrolled or accepted into an upcoming technical / trade program from a recognized post-secondary institution as a full time student.
4. Applicants must provide a current Grade 12 and /or post-secondary institution transcript.
