Interested in taking part in exciting archaeological and geographical research in the Port au Choix region and love the outdoor no matter what the weather? If you are a Qalipu Mi'kmaq high school student interested in working closely with a Memorial University graduate student in a peer partnership of knowledge exchange, this project could be just for you.

You are invited to apply to work with the Port au Choix Archaeology Project (MUN) on a venture to discover how the Groswater Arctic Peoples lived in the Port au Choix region and what the environment was like at that time (2800 years ago). The successful applicant will live with the crew in Port au Choix (unless they live close by) from July 2- July 30 and will work six days per week as an archaeological excavator and geographical data collector.
