These positions are spare and relief and candidates can expect to work on an on call basis.

As designated by the Second Engineer or their designate, the main responsibility of the Certified Engine Room Assistant is to keep all machinery spaces and equipment clean and free of hazards to ensure a safe working environment. This position must also fully understand the tasks to safely discharge or receive fuel, lube and dirty oils; and in handling engine room chemicals. The Certified Engine Room Assistant must also be able to perform all watchkeeping duties assigned, stand fire watches, and be familiar with the layout of the vessel.

This position is required to perform or assist in all maintenance activities, and show good mechanical skills and judgment, with the ability to follow written and oral instructions.
