Any required repairs to assigned equipment are communicated to maintenance personnel;
Read and enter comments into daily operator log book.

The Equipment Operator shall:

Operate all assigned equipment in a safe and effective manner;
Complete and document a pre-operational check on assigned equipment;
Grease and Fuel equipment as necessary;
Ensure loads are legal weight;
Ensure all equipment has proper safety equipment in place;
Keep interior clean;
Load and unload equipment from the low-bed;
Fill water tanks as necessary;
Maintain a cooperative working relationship with customers and other employees;
Willingness to train new and inexperienced team members;
Participate in JHA's, FLRA's and line-up meetings ;
Perform other related duties as assigned by the Shift Supervisor.
