- Assisting in the accomplishment of vessel functions by performing other related duties as required

What will my schedule look like?

While these positions are considered on-call, spare and relief, our goal is to provide a schedule of 15 days of work during a month with 15 days off. Spare and relief employees may not always work 15 days in a month, and the days may not always be consecutive. The schedule will vary depending on operational and staffing requirements.

- Ability to lift, handle, and carry heavy objects up to 22.3 kg
- Ability to work in confined spaces
