The Science Instructor will work with current faculty on course delivery in a pedagogically sound manner.

- Masters in Biological Sciences or Environmental Science, Ecology, Microbiology, etc.
- A permanent Manitoba teaching certificate (or equivalent from another jurisdiction)
- Experience in lab demonstration and lab maintenance
- Experience with tutoring or teaching first-year university courses
- Excellent communication skills
- Excellent organizational skills
- Experience in using distance and current learning technologies and current computer applications
- Demonstrated ability to understand cultural influences and issues specific to Aboriginal learners and mature students in northern communities
- Personal experience and/or knowledge and understanding Aboriginal cultures

- Experience in Indigenous education settings
- Research experience in a university or government agency
