Students pursuing an education in the technology and trades are considered priority applicants.

### HOW TO APPLY

1. Applicants must complete a Bird Heavy Civil Ltd. application form.
2. Applicants must provide (2) character reference letters.
3. Applicants must be enrolled or accepted into an upcoming technical / trade program from a recognized post-secondary institution as a full-time student.
4. Applicants must provide a current Grade 12 and /or post-secondary institution transcript.
