EMERGING LEADER SCHOLARSHIPS

Four \$2,500 awards to students entering any year of a full time post-secondary education program in the areas of Power Engineering, Power Line Technician, Instrumentation Tech, Engineering, Technology, Business, Marketing & Communications, Environmental Sciences or Law.

WOMEN IN TRADES, ENGINEERING, & TECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIPS

Six \$2,500 awards to female students entering any year of a full time post-secondary education program in Trades or in the areas of Engineering and Technology.

AFRICAN NOVA SCOTIAN SCHOLARSHIPS

Four \$2,500 awards to African Nova Scotian students entering any year of a full time post-secondary education program in the areas of Power Engineering, Power Line Technician, Instrumentation Tech, Engineering, Technology, Business, Marketing & Communications, Environmental Sciences or Law.

NOVA SCOTIA POWER FAMILY SCHOLARSHIPS

Ten \$1,000 awards to children/dependents of employees or retirees of Nova Scotia Power. These awards are available to students entering any year of a full time post-secondary education program.

MI'KMAQ BURSARIES

Four \$1000 awards are available to Mi'kmaw students entering any year of a full time post-secondary education program. Past recipient winners can re-apply each year.

Recipients may also have the opportunity to participate in a 12-week paid internship at Nova Scotia Power during their term of study.
