

Call for Artists and Craftspeople – Online Indigenous Art & Craft Auction

Experience Qalipu is excited to announce an online auction of Indigenous art and craft. Experience Qalipu will create a Facebook Group where artists and craftspeople can post their items for auction. Individual artists will set a starting bid, bid increment and shipping cost. All the transactions will happen directly between the artist/craftsperson and the buyer. 100% of the money raised goes directly back to the artist/craftsperson.

This will be a live Facebook auction that will run for 3 days starting on November 6, 2020 at 12:00pm and ending on November 8, 2020 at 5:59pm. All artists and craftspeople must have their items posted to the group before the start of the event. There will be a document explaining how to post your items at a later date.

Rules:

- 1. Artists/craftspeople must be either a member of Qalipu First Nation OR self-identify as Indigenous
- 2. Artists/craftspeople must post their own products only. If you are posting work on behalf of a family member, the post must state who the item was made by.
- 3. Artists/craftspeople are responsible for setting the auction starting price, bid increments, shipping information, payment information (e-transer, PayPal, etc)
- 4. Each artist/craftsperson can post a maximum of 15 items to the group
- 5. Artist/craftsperson is responsible for accepting payment from auction item winner
- 6. Artist/craftsperson is responsible for coordinating the shipping or local pick up with the auction item winner while practicing physical distancing
- 7. All products must be completed before the auction starts
- 8. Actual photo of the work must be uploaded to the auction (1 item per photo)
- 9. Experience Qalipu will create the one-time online auction Facebook group
- 10. Experience Qalipu will announce the winners of each item by commenting on each photo
- 11. Experience Qalipu will not profit or accept any monies for the auction
