



Qalipu Mi'kmaq First Nation (QMFN) needs your help as it begins work on the development of a Cultural Foundation.

Some members of the Band will have grown up with stories and knowledge of the Mi'kmaq culture. However, many members will have little information and knowledge of their heritage. QMFN will be making a significant effort to reach out to these individuals and provide them with information and experiences that will assist them in the discovery of our collective past.

A Cultural Foundation has been identified as a successful way to generate resources and will be responsible for preserving and promoting the culture, language, and traditions of the Qalipu Mi'kmaq people of Newfoundland and Labrador. We want to identify Band members who have a commitment to preserving and promoting culture and heritage and to designate cultural ambassadors. The Foundation is seen as a great way to address cultural documentation issues and promote the involvement of youth and Elders in cultural activities within the Band.
