Dispatch Engineer

Reporting to the Technical Services Manager, the Dispatch Engineer is responsible for managing the implementation and operation of mine dispatching and data recording system. This role will deliver technical support to the production and engineering team. The Dispatch Engineer will be responsible for all technical aspects of the dispatch system functions to ensure production objectives are met in a safe, environmentally responsible, and efficient manner.

To be successful in this role we are looking for someone with excellent interpersonal and communication skills, who is a self-starter with the ability to own their role and motivate others. Someone who is adaptable, energetic, has strong attention to detail, and an interest in continuous improvement. The ability to multitask and prioritize contending demands is vital in this role.

This position is located at the Project site, working on a 14 days in/14 days out rotation.

Accountabilities/Responsibilities:

- Demonstrates leadership in Health, Safety and Environment through personal behaviors and conversations.
- Establish and promote a respectful and healthy work environment at all times.
- Actively participate in and help lead site safety initiatives.
- Ensure the equipment fleet is optimized to maximize production.
- Minimize operating costs at all times, including a clear focus on equipment (truck) productivities.
- Ensure equipment line up sheets are created in a timely manner and adhere to all the sites requirements.
- Operate the Fleet Control systems to optimize equipment utilization, productivity, and operating costs.
- Ensure crew morale remains positive in a fast-paced, team environment.
- Enter crew payroll and equipment coding for the purposes of tracking hours and compensation.
- Responsible for overall Dispatching System for operation and maintenance.
- Daily interaction with dispatch personnel, and provide expert assistance as required.
- Liaise with designated personnel to ensure timely system inputs (e.g. material files).
- Analyze data quality by reviewing the cycles daily and provide reports as required.

- Maintain onboard configuration for dispatch equipment and data files.
- Manage operator licensing.
- Assist in identifying training needs.
- Adhere to all company policies and procedures.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Education and Experience Required:

- Bachelor's Degree in Mining, Engineering, or IT-related field required.
- Professional Engineering designation is a requirement.
- Minimum of 5 years of experience in a similar role within an industrial and/or mining environment.
- Experience at a remote site is required.

Skills and Knowledge:

- Ability to develop and maintain professional working relationships with other groups, including the Crush & Convey and Process group to optimize the plans of current and future mining activities required.
- Experience in setting up networks, including microwave systems preferred.
- Experience with Microsoft Office, SQL databases, and Business Objects preferred.
- Team leader, problem solver, and excellent oral and written communication skills required.
- Ability to work outside in varied weather conditions for extended periods of time required.
- Ability to cross-train with the IT and dispatch group required.
- Ability to perform the essential functions.
- A valid driver's license and driver's abstract required.
