Reporting to the Exploration Supervisor, the Geology Student will be a part of a number of active field programs, including geological and geotechnican core logging, prospecting, till sampling, trenching. They will be responsible for sample collection and ensuring adherence to the company's quality assurance and quality control (QA/QC) program.

This position is located at the Project site, working on a 2 week in/2 week out rotation.

Accountabilities/Responsibilities:

- Participating in field work collecting, analyzing, and documenting rock grab, channel and till samples.
- Assisting with geological drill core logging and sampling.
- Conducting geotechnical drill core logging.
- Directing drill and labour crew as needed.
- Surveying proposed drill targets, final drill hole locations, trench outlines and sample locations.
- Geological mapping.
- Data compilation and interpretation.
- Performing housekeeping duties as required.
- Actively participating in daily toolbox talks.
- Other duties as assigned.
