Reporting to the Exploration Manager or the Senior Mine Geologist, the Geology Student will be a part of a number of active field programs, including reverse circulation (RC) drilling, prospecting, till sampling, trenching and blasthole sampling. They will be responsible for sample collection and ensuring adherence to the company's quality assurance and quality control (QA/QC) program.

This position is located at the Project site, working on a 2 week in/2 week out rotation.

Accountabilities/Responsibilities:

- Participating in field work collecting, analyzing, and documenting rock grab, RC chip, channel and till samples.
- Directing drill and labour crew as needed.
- Surveying proposed drill targets, final drill hole locations, trench outlines and sample locations.
- Geological mapping.
- Data compilation and interpretation.
- Performing housekeeping duties as required.
- Actively participating in daily toolbox talks.
- Other duties as assigned.

Education and Experience:

- Currently enrolled in, or previously completed, a Bachelor of Science degree program in Earth Sciences.
- Experience in a remote construction or operational setting with shift/rotations is an asset.
- Experience in a Mining or similar industrial setting is considered an asset.
