- Acts as the Corporation's Alternate Company Security Officer.
- Provides direction as regulated by Transport Canada as the MSFO to a network of security guards and staff.
- Identifies protection goals, objectives and metrics consistent with the corporate plan and strategic goals.

- Assists the Manager Corporate Security and Emergency Preparedness in the development and implementation of security policies, standards, guidelines and procedures.
- Assisting with security architecture, access control, monitoring policies and systems, and employee education and awareness.
- Works closely with managers to prioritize security initiatives and spending based on appropriate risk management and/or financial methodology.
- Assists with planning, organizing, coordinating, and directing security and safety personnel in the performance of security functions.
- Maintains close relationships with local, provincial and federal law enforcement and other related government agencies.
- Oversees incident response planning as well as the investigation of security breaches, and assists with disciplinary and legal matters as necessary.
- Participates closely in related areas such as business continuity planning, loss prevention and fraud prevention, and privacy.
- Promotes a safe working environment; conducts toolbox meetings, develops Job Safety Analysis and addresses unsafe work practices.
- Investigate incidents, conduct root cause analysis, prepare reports and makes recommendations related to employee injuries, property damage, vehicle incidents.
