Job Description

Reporting to the Exploration Manager, the Geological Technician will collect, analyze, and document, geotechnical data. In addition, they will complete downhole surveying using Reflex survey equipment. This position is site-based on a 16/12 rotation.

Accountabilities

- Collecting, analyzing, and documenting geotechnical data, including rock mass rating testing, of oriented and non-oriented diamond drill core.
- Performing downhole surveys on drill holes using Reflex survey equipment.
- Taking and processing high quality photography and measurements of diamond drill core.
- Assisting with sampling of diamond drill core.
- Performing housekeeping activities as required.
- Actively participating in daily toolbox talks.
- Other duties as assigned.

Education

Bachelor's Degree in Geology or Earth Sciences or formal training as a Geological Technician is recommended.

Experience

- 1-3 years of experience in a related position.
- Experience in a remote construction or operational setting is considered an asset.
- Experience in a Mining or similar industrial setting is considered an asset.
