Reporting to the Metallurgist, the Metallurgical Technician will support the process plant metallurgical team in day-to-day operations.

This position is located at the Project site, working on a 14 days in/14 days out rotation.

Accountabilities/Responsibilities:

- Interpret and follow Standard Operating Procedures to efficiently achieve metallurgical performance and quality objectives.
- Perform routine sampling, metallurgical lab test work, and data entry/analysis.
- Lab tests include, but are not limited to, cyanide leach tests, carbon quality control testing, core density tests, plant sampling, solution analysis, sample preparation, particle size analysis, and plant inventory sampling.
