Millwright

Reporting to the Process Plant Maintenance Supervisor, the Millwright is responsible for the installation and maintenance of various pieces of equipment and tools. In addition, this role is responsible for reviewing and understanding diagrams and service manuals to determine how to properly install, repair, or disassemble specific equipment and tools.

This position is located at the Project site, working on a 14 days in/14 days out rotation.

Accountabilities/Responsibilities:

- Inspect, examine, and test parts in order to recommend the extent and nature of the work to be

- Adjust, repair, or replace defective parts and components of the equipment systems.
- Clean, lubricate, and perform other routine maintenance work on equipment.

- Conduct final inspections to ensure that work detailed on work order has been completed to meet safety standards.
- Provide feedback improvement suggestions to the supervisor and planner and implement those that are within your ability.
- Improve equipment availability and efficiency through quality maintenance and failure analysis.
- Adhere to all company policies and procedures.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

- Minimum of 5 years Journeyperson experience in a mining or heavy industrial environment is required.
