Pit Sampler

Reporting to the Senior Mine Geologist, the Pit Sampler acts as a support role for the grade control program. They are responsible for collecting rock and chip samples, while ensuring safety and accuracy.

This position is located at the Project site, working on a 14 days in/14 days out rotation.

Responsibilities/Accountabilities:

- Collect rock and chip samples in accordance with standard operating procedures.
- Record and dispatch samples, ensuring quality control and proper documentation.
- Maintain sampling equipment and ensure adherence to health and safety protocols.
- Collaborate with geologists, engineers, environmental scientists, and other team members to integrate sampling data into broader project analysis.
- Perform manual tasks (e.g., shoveling, lifting, and digging) as required.
- Offload site deliveries and maintain an organized inventory of sampling supplies.
- Ensure that all equipment is maintained and in proper working condition.
- Follow all health, safety, and quality assurance protocols.
- Perform housekeeping activities to maintain a clean and safe workspace.

Qualifications:

- High School Diploma or equivalent.
- Minimum of 2 years of experience in an open-pit mining environment preferred.
- Experience working in a remote setting and rotating shifts is an asset.
- Experience with mine dewatering systems, drilling, and blasting is an advantage.
