Receiving/Sample Prep Technician

Reporting to the Chief Assayer, the Receiving/Sample Prep Technician will be responsible for ensuring a clean and organized receiving and sample preparation area, along with ensuring maintenance and cleanliness of equipment.

The Receiving/Sample Prep Technician will be responsible for sorting and recording samples to ensure they correlate with the receiving manifest. Drying, crushing, riffing, and pulverizing will be important aspects of this position.

This position is located at the Project site, working a 14 days in/14 days out rotation, with extended hours as required due to periods of peak workloads.

Accountabilities/Responsibilities:

- Support and assist in promoting a health and safety culture.
- Capable of following provided procedures to efficiently achieve project production and quality objectives.
- Receiving, preparation and management of the receiving and preparation area.
- Submit samples to the Leachwell Lab, Fire Lab or Chemistry lab as per analysis requisition. Assist in these labs as time permits.
- Maintain a clean receiving and preparation area.
- Report equipment damage or failures, hazard or required maintenance to the lab supervisor. Maintain an organized sample storage area and assist with weighing, analysis or cleanup as time permits.
- Perform other duties as required.

Education and Accreditation

- High School diploma or equivalent.
- Must have the ability to do repetitive lifts and turns for several hours per day handling a 14 Kg – 31 lb pulverizer bowl.
- Previous mining experience, preferably in a remote industrial environment.
- Previous experience in a mining or commercial laboratory an asset.
- Experience using lab jaw crusher and ring and puck or disc mills an asset.
- Mechanically inclined an asset.
- A valid driver license and a driver's abstract.
