Carpenter

Reporting to the Site Sevices Maintenance Supervisor, the Carpenter is responsible for the maintenance and repair of the all Camp and Site Services infrastructures. Inaddition, this role is responsible for reviewing and understanding blueprints and building plans to determine how to properly renovate, install, repair, or disassemble specific structures.

This position is located at the Project site, working on a 14 days in/14 days out rotation.

Accountabilities/Responsibilities:

- Provide support to Site Services through diligent and quality workmanships of various hands-on construction task that include carpentry, trim work, various repairs, deficiency corrections and other miscellaneous construction activities.
- Repair all pre-delivery inspection deficiencies.
- Ensure company vehicle and tools provided are maintained in a safe operational condition.
- Adhere to all company policies and procedures.
- Read and interpret blueprints, drawings, and specifications.
- Operate a variety of hand and power tools to perform carpentry tasks, including measuring, cutting, and installing building materials such as wood, metal, and drywall.
- Inspect and repair flat membrane roofs for deficiencies and leaks.
- Jacking and levelling of modular units.
- Ability to perform other duties such as foundation, siteworks, tiling, plumbing and other trades experience is considered an asset.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

- A minimum of 5 years Journeyperson experience in a mining or heavy industrial environment is required.
- Experience working in a remote industrial environment is preferred.
- A solid understanding of all construction trades and construction techniques.
- Red Seal Journeyperson Plumbing certificate, would be considered an asset
