OUR ENGAGEMENT COMMITMENT.

Cahill is committed to working effectively and collaboratively with First Nation, Métis, and Inuit communities and businesses to create sustainable opportunities across Canada. This is achieved through community support and involvement, local capacity building, business prospects, and employment and training opportunities.

ELIGIBILITY AND APPLICATION PROCESS:

- Member of Qalipu First Nation;
- Provide proof of current full-time enrolment at a recognized post-secondary educational institute;
- Write a 250 word (maximum) essay on why you are passionate about your program of choice, and how it impacts your community and/or today's society.

THE CAHILL INDIGENOUS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM IS GOVERNED BY THE FOLLOWING:

- Maximum of 10 Scholarships will be awarded across Canada per year valued at \$500 each.
- Students must re-apply to be considered for future scholarships. The maximum cumulative scholarship awarded per individual is \$2,000.
- The value of the scholarship is not reduced or waived for applicants who may be eligible to receive other scholarships or grants.
- Scholarships will be issued in January 2025.
- Applicants who are dismissed from, fail to attend, or withdraw from the post-secondary institution before the issuance of the scholarship, forfeit their right to the scholarship for that year.

DEADLINE: January 10, 2025. Unfortunately, deadline extensions are not permitted.
