The Manager of Indigenous/Labour Relations & External Affairs will work with the Labour Relations Site Representative (Site Rep) and play a key role in providing leadership and conducting the affairs of Trades NL and the Resource Development Trades Council (RDTTC) on the assigned work sites and within the organizations.

The incumbent will be responsible and accountable for the administration of labour relations activities as they relate to all aspects of the collective agreement and conflict resolution on site between contractors and employees, as well as external relations.

The ideal candidate will be a team-oriented individual with demonstrated successful leadership experience and capabilities of developing and maintaining strong relationships with all stakeholders.
