- Excellent problem-solving and critical thinking skills
- Excellent computer skills including proficiency in MS Office tools
- Demonstrated attention to maintenance of safe workplaces
- Prior experience in instruction
- Personal experience and/or knowledge and understanding of the Aboriginal cultures

- Experience in instructing adult learners in northern or remote communities
- The ability to speak an Aboriginal language

All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadians and permanent residents will be given priority.
