

Note to Employer.

Qalipu First Nation Band members who reside in Newfoundland and Labrador who were essential workers during the COVID-19 pandemic, and incurred childcare costs, are eligible to apply for up to \$200 in monthly benefits per child (ages 0-13). This benefit can be paid retroactively starting in April 2020 and will require a letter from the members' employer verifying their status as an essential worker.

Essential services are those services and functions that are necessary during a pandemic to preserve life, health, public safety, and basic societal functioning to the residents of the province.

An employee with your organization has applied for childcare support from Qalipu First Nation. Please confirm that this employee has been deemed an essential employee and is essential for your business/organization to continue operating during the pandemic.
