STUDENTS WILL NOT BE CERTIFIED LICENSED GUIDES OR TRAPPERS BY COMPLETING THIS COURSE.** It is the responsibility of the student to contact the Wildlife Division of the Department of Fisheries, Forestry and Agriculture to obtain the Guide and Trapping Certification.
