



QALIPU FIRST NATION HOME REPAIR PROGRAM APPLICATION ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINE

Introduction:

Qalipu First Nation Home Repair Program serves as a basis to provide financial support opportunities for band members with respect to housing repair and maintenance to increase the sustainability and longevity of their home. Successful applicants are eligible to receive up to a maximum of \$5,000.00 in assistance per application as program funding is limited.

Program Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a registered member of Qalipu First Nation
- Applicant and/or Co-Applicant are required to be a resident of Newfoundland and Labrador
- Applicant is required to provide **proof of combined annual income, proof of home ownership, and sales quotes for materials, supplies, and labour**
- **Requirement of combined household income must be below \$34,866.00, based on Government definition of "Low Income Taxable Reduction – LITR"**
- Additional supporting documents such letters of support, letter from Service NL and/or photographs of repair and maintenance that is required may be requested

Qalipu First Nation Home Repair Program is available to support homeowners in regard to the following priority areas:

- **Priority One:** Emergency repairs that would cause the homeowner to leave their home immediately
- **Priority Two:** Heating, Electrical, and Plumbing
- **Priority Three:** Structure, foundation, and roofing
- **Priority Four:** Windows, Doors, and siding

Please note: If housing ownership is in the name of a non-member spouse or partner (co-applicant), you may still submit your application with that document; however, it will be necessary to provide further documentation to support that you are a resident of the same household.

Application Process:

- Qalipu Home Repair application collection will be open to members from **April 25th to June 24th, 2022**. Applications **MUST** be received by 4:00pm on **June 24th, 2022**. If application and all supporting documents are mailed, then the application **MUST** be post marked on or before **June 24th, 2022**.

- Limit of one application per household. Duplicate applications will not be reviewed. In the event duplicate applications are received, QFN will consider the first application received as the valid submission.
- All applications require name, accurate mailing address/street address (if different from mailing address), Band registration #, phone number and/or email address, and supporting documentation such as proof of home ownership and proof of combined annual income based on what support services are being requested.
