ELIGIBILITY

Scholarship applications will be accepted from Qalipu students who are currently enrolled in a recognized post-secondary institution and have successfully completed at least one semester in recognized technical/trades program. Students pursuing an education in technology or trades associated with the mining industry will be considered priority applicants.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Applicants must complete a Marathon Gold Corporation – Qalipu First Nation Scholarship application form.
2. Applicants must provide at least (1) character reference in the form of a recommendation letter.
3. Applicants must have successfully completed at least one semester in a technical/trade program from a recognized post-secondary institution as a full-time student.
4. Applicants must be in good academic standing and provide a copy of their most recent post-secondary transcript.
