

"QALIPU FIRST NATION HOME ENERGY EFFICIENCY INITIATIVE"

APPLICATION ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINE

Introduction:

The "Home Energy Efficiency Initiative" will provide financial assistance to existing homeowners to purchase and install heat pumps with the goal of reducing home heating costs and overall greenhouse gas emissions.

Program Eligibility/Criteria:

- Applicant must be a registered member of Qalipu First Nation
- Applicant and/or Co-Applicant are required to be a current resident of Newfoundland and Labrador and residing in the home requesting assistance.
- Applicant must use either wood or oil as a heating source in their home.
- Applicant MUST not have been supported under NRCan, Greener Homes Grant, or TakeChargeNL to support the installation of an existing heat pump.
- Applicant is required to provide the following:
 - Proof of home ownership (must not be a 'rent to own' agreement)
 - All quotes associated with the cost of the heat pump unit, installation, and removal of the existing oil tank, wood stove, or furnace if applicable.
 - QFN reserves the right to review/assess all quotes, and request further quotes if necessary.
 - Proof of combined annual household net income (Copy of most recent Notice of Assessment from the Canada Revenue Agency <u>MUST</u> be included with application)
- Combined household income must not exceed:

- QFN housing staff may request additional information to support the application review process.
- Applicant must provide proof of energy consumption (NL Power bill(s), oil receipt/statement, etc.)

<u>Please note:</u> *If home ownership is in the name of a non-member spouse or partner (co-applicant), you may still submit your application with the necessary supporting documentation; however, it may be required to provide further documentation to support that you are a resident of the same household.

Application Process:

- The "Qalipu First Nation Home Energy Efficiency Initiative" application collection will be open to band members beginning June 24th, 2025, and will close July 31, 2025.
- Due to limited funding and the anticipated high demand, all applications deemed eligible will be included in a random draw to select approvals.

- Proof of monthly energy consumption (At least three (3) months of utility/oil bills and/or wood consumption required)
- Any additional documentation that may support your application
