

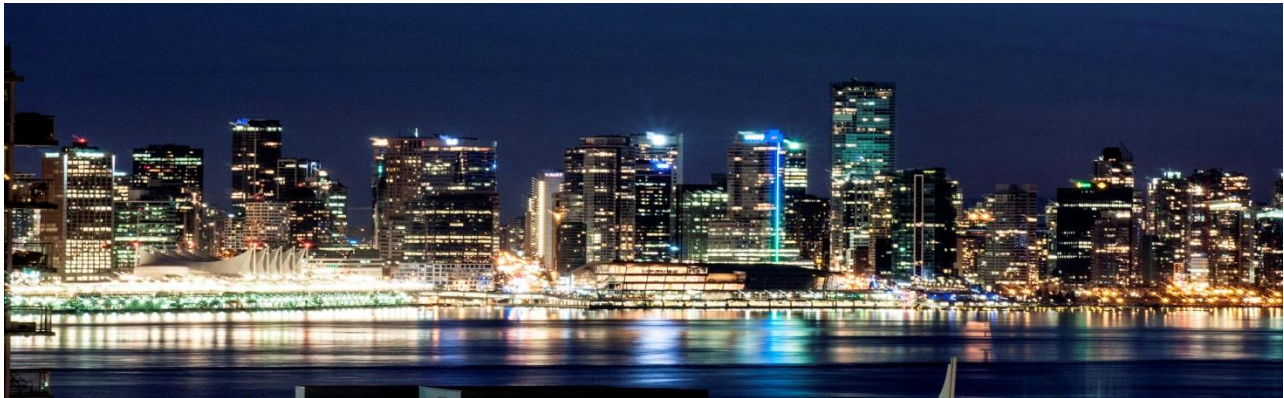

## How to apply

Please submit the following in order to be eligible to apply:

- (a) Filled out application form (above)
- (b) Resume **OR** short biography
- (c) Artistic Piece: Submit a video, photograph or short essay (see below for guidelines)

## Guidelines for your Artistic Piece

Please submit one of the following as part of your application:

- 1) **Video**- Create and upload a video demonstrating what *Community Values and Decisions* means to you and your community. The video has to be 3 minutes or less. Upload it to your own YouTube account (it's easy to create one) and tag it as #YouthPanelContest2013.
- 2) **Photograph** - Take a photo demonstrating what *Community Values and Decisions* means to you and your community. You can apply any filters or effects you want, but it can't be larger than 3 megabytes (that's pretty big). It has to be saved in .jpeg, .jpg or .gif format. The photograph should come with a 300 word explanation about why you chose it and how it relates to the theme.
- 3) **Short Essay** - Please explain what *Community Values and Decisions* means to you and your community. The essay should be no more than 600 words in length and saved as a .pdf, .doc or .docx.

**Applications will be accepted before 5 p.m. PST on Tuesday, September 24<sup>th</sup>, 2013. Applicants will be notified during the first week of October.**
